

1. Only academic staff (unclassified) involved officially in departmental committees and governance.
2. Faculty Policies and Procedures 5.10. DEPARTMENTAL FACULTIES: MEMBERSHIP.
  - The departmental executive committee may extend the right to vote and participate in departmental meetings to members of the academic staff (see 1.03.).
  - The departmental executive committee also may invite members of the academic staff to participate in the annual preference balloting for department chair.
  - Invitation to participate in governance is for a specified term of not greater than three years and is made only by the executive committee (see 5.22.C.).
  - Invitations to participate in governance are renewable.
3. (via secretary of faculty): A committee appointed by the departmental chair and reporting to the chair does not have to have a majority of faculty as voting members.
4. Motions:
  1. The Academic Staff Committee should have equal representation of voting members from the faculty and the academic staff of the department (advisory to the departmental chair).
  2. Two (2) representatives of the department's academic staff be invited to participate as voting member in faculty meeting. The academic staff representatives will be selected by the departmental support staff participating in an open balloting process. (advisory to the Executive Committee)
